


Active Leisure Entertainment

Golf is rapidly gaining in popularity in Lithuania. The landscape of the country is favourable for golf course development. Human contribution does not have to be huge for the country's wild nature to turned into the finest golf courses. So grab your clubs and go ahead and discover Lithuanian golf courses!

1. Capitals Golf Club

This course is located at the crossroad of pathways linking the historical capitals of Lithuania: Kernavė, Trakai, Kaunas, and Vilnius. Once a place for the noblemen of Kernavė and Trakai to hunt, these hills, fields and woods are now a place for the best golfers in Lithuania and from around the world to play.

Terrain ideally suitable for golf courses was formed by moving glaciers. It was the beauty of the landscape that inspired Peter Chamberlain, a former professional golf player and now a coach, to design a golf course in this particular place.



Capitals Golf Club is the first professional 18-hole golf course in Lithuania. Opened in 2006, the club has since organised 30 tournaments and 250 events during its short existence. Women who enjoy playing golf have established a "women's club" in the centre and gather once a week to play and enjoy some entertainment and relaxation.

In 2007 the USA journal "Golf Inc" selected the Capitals Golf Club as the best newly developed golf course in its international divi-

The club houses a small hotel with four double rooms. It also contains a restaurant "19 duobutė" (The 19th hole), and a golf shop.

Places of interest

Climb The Black Hill located near Pipiriškės village, between Pasamanė and Purvis lakes. Archaeological excavations indicate that



people have been living here for at least three thousand years.

The Capitals Golf Club is situated close to the historical capitals of Lithuania. If you are visiting the club, you should not miss the chance to see them all: Vilnius and its old town, which is listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List; Kernavé, which is a UNESCO protected site; Trakai, which possesses the only castle located on an island; and Kaunas.

Come and play a round in the centre of Europe! The golf course surrounds the geographical centre of Europe, as determined by scientists of the French National Institute of Geography in 1989.

This 18-hole golf course is just 26 kilometres from Vilnius which offers a wide variety of accommodation, catering, entertainment and other services. The course occupies an area of over 83 hectares, and the length of the courses totals 6600 metres. In addition, the Molètai region, which is famous for its lakes and perfectly suitable for tourism, is close-by.

The golf course includes numerous water hazards such as Lake Girija, and numerous water channels, which will constantly keep you on your toes! Lessons with a professional instructor are available and there are driving



range and putting green facilities, as well as a golf shop. Visitors can have a snack or meal in the Italian restaurant "Da Antonio".

Places of interest

Bernotai mound, located close to the golf course, was used as a defence wall from the 1st to the 12th century. While on the mound, enjoy the panoramic view from the top. The area also boasts the Struvė Geodesic Arc station, which is listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List, only 5 kilometres away in Meškonys village.

This golf course, located in the Kaunas district by the Neris river, has a group of dedicated members as well as its own traditions. The surroundings are famous for picturesque hills and ravines. In fact, the landscape was the crucial factor in the choice of this site as the first golf course to be built in Lithuania.

At the moment the golf course includes 9 holes, the length of which totals 1270 metres. There are plans to develop the course in the future. The club offers private and group less-



ons, and visitors may also take the green card exam. There is a hotel in case you need accommodation.

An unique entertainment activity is the commercial hunting of Sika deer. So if you wish to combine two passions, i.e. golf and hunting, this is the perfect place for you.

Places of interest

When in Kaunas, visit the museum of M.K.Čiurlionis, a famous Lithuanian painter and composer, enjoy the view of the city from a cable railway, walk around the Devils' Museum – the only such museum in the world and storing over 3000 "devilish" exhibits.

"The National Golf Resort" is situated in a geographically favourable position, i.e. barely 4 kilometres from the city of Klaipėda and only 20 minutes from Palanga Airport. So, as soon as you step out of the plane, the amazing natural surroundings of the Lithuanian seaside embrace you immediately.

In the valley of the Dane river, there is a classical "72 par" golf course, conforming to world standards with a practice area and a 3-hole short-game. The differences in height varies around the course and in some places reaches as much as 30 metres.









Visitors are invited to have a meal in a restaurant with a terrace overlooking the golf course. Those wishing to stay overnight are offered spacious double rooms and apartment-style rooms with terraces in a luxurious villa.

The clubhouse also contains 2 modern conference halls seating 30 and 70 people; a golf shop is also open.

Take a stroll in the homely old town of Klaipėda, reminding you of the dramatic history of Lithuania Minor, relax on beaches of snow-white sand, or marvel at the sea life in the Sea Museum!



Water entertainment parks

This manual presents three modern entertainment centres. Two of them are based in the top-rated Lithuanian resort – Druskininkai, which boasts natural salty mineral water springs and is loved for a mild and warm microclimate as well as its scenic nature. The third park is located in Vilnius, at the very centre of entertainment that the capital has to offer.

6. Druskininkai water park



Adrenaline seekers first rush to the slide tower with six different open and enclosed slides and the pool area located under a magnificent dome. You will slide through the longest (212 metres) pipe "Bermudai" (Bermudas) at a breathtaking speed, whereas the twists and turns of "Ekstremalusis" (The Extreme One) will provide you

an adrenaline pumping experience. Get ready for a wet and daring adventure!

The pool area features a huge (1,800 square metres) pool with cascading waterfalls and underwater currents that will pleasantly sooth and massage your body.

Catch rolling surf in the high tide wave pool, try to conquer river stream or enjoy the pleasures of a sauna. You are offered a choice of 20 saunas designed according to the traditions of different countries: 9 dry saunas, 10 steam baths, and the Turkish Hamam sauna. Try special free sauna programmes with honey, salt, veniks (bundled leafy oak/birch tree twigs), aromas, and masks.



You will find amusement not only inside but also outside where a pool, bubble bath and icy-water cascades are awaiting for you. A spa centre "Aqua rojus" (Aqua paradise) is attached to the complex offering rejuvenating and nurturing body and face therapy, as well as massages. After the professional touch of experienced specialists you will leave the centre feeling a few years younger.

Places of interest

Visit the Dzūkija National Park. It contains nature reserves and preserved areas that protect rare species of plants and animals, mounds, ancient villages, etc. More information is available at www.dzukijosparkas.lt.

Places of interest

Enjoy the shores of the Nemunas river by joining a three-hour trip to Liškiava by steamboat. You will spend 1 hour and 20 minutes on a tour of Liškiava – a village on the bank of the Nemunas river which is famous for its baroque-style monastery and The Holy Trinity Church. The rest of the trip will be spent on the boat enjoying the scenic views along the Nemunas river.

The water park in the capital has been designed with a Polynesian isles theme. The centre is capable of accommodating up to 1,500 visitors at one time. Can you imagine the size of the park and the variety of facilities you are about to explore?

The park is equipped with 9 attractions that are the most up-to-date in the Baltic States. It contains the largest indoor water park, "The Yell of the Maori", which functions on a pendulum principle and guarantees a state of weightlessness. The length of the slide is 115 metres. "Moorea Volcano" and "Fiji Tornado" will allow you to reach a speed of 60km/h. Take a deep breath and dive ahead into the warm water!


"Tonga Snake" is a winding, extra long (159 metres) ride with a slope reaching 13 percent. Have you never ridden a mountain river? Well its high time you tried! "Ohana River" is a spacious attraction for the whole family.

If you are missing the sea – do not miss the chance to visit the "Dolphin Sea" with 1.5 metre waves to jump over. Come and enjoy the refreshing surge of breaking waves.

The park also contains a sauna area offering the chance to relax in five different types of saunas. If you are warm, visit the "Aoraki snow" room with real snowflakes falling on you. Alternatively, go and relax in "Tropical rain" showers with the effects of colours and aromas.

If you feel like like quietly looking around the whole water park, get carried along by the stream of a river - a "canal" in the pool that flows though the whole water park









area. During summer time it also flows outside where a real beach with a sunbathing area and an outdoor bar operate, too. Three whirlpool baths are available in "Vichy" water park, each of them being situated on the three different storeys. The park also features a massage saloon, snack-bar and two bars. Children can enjoy "Žaidimų sala" (Game island) where they will find 50 different attractions to choose from.

Places of interest

After the Polynesian heat one is probably craving for the Lithuanian winter, right? We have a ski trail in Vilnius, which is worth trying. It is designed on an artificial mountain that local residents often call "Laimis Hill".

When was the last time you climbed a tree? Have you ever walked on a swinging rope with the sight of tree branches and people looking like tiny ants below? Have you ever jumped from one tree onto another? You haven't? This means it is the time for you to test your strength and courage.

A number of fine adventure parks are available in Lithuania for active leisure enthusiasts. They all do their best to surprise their visitors by introducing creative and original activities.

Is there a better place than in a treetop to know your true friends and yourself better?

The majority of nature trail campgrounds have limitations on the number of visitors, and you should therefore book places and time in advance.

The biggest adventure park in Lithuania, "ONE Adventure Park", is located in Druskininkai, in a pinewood on the bank of the largest river in Lithuania – the Nemunas. Druskininkai is a balneological resort providing mud therapy, mineral water, and climate therapy services. The countryside itself pro-

vides favourable conditions: fresh air, scenic landscapes, and ideal conditions for active leisure activities.

The park covers a territory of 3 hectares. 10 tracks of different levels have been set up in trees. Their length totals 3 kilometres. The longest trail in Lithuania - 600 metres long is in this park. The highest point in the campground reaches over 16 metres.

Visitors have a choice of 130 tracks, including 30 adrenaline pumping zip-line flights from tree to tree (4 of them are over the Nemunas river). The most extreme and exhilarating is "Tarzan's Flight Over Nemunas".

The novelty of the park is the two-level race track - the only one in Lithuania. If you have come with a friend, it is an ideal opportunity to check which of you is braver, stronger, and quicker!

Adventure seekers are also offered night expeditions.

You can have a snack or drink in the park's café.

Places of interest

Visit the unique Grūtas park. This is a sculpture garden of Soviet-era statues (Stalin, Lenin, and other political figures of the Soviet Union),

which were taken down from the squares of Lithuanian cities, towns, and villages as well as other Soviet ideological relics. A list of the world's strangest museums, compiled by the "Lonely Planet" lists Grūtas park in fourth position.


In winter the services are available only for groups of over 20 people.

Visitors are welcome from 10 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.

In the entertainment and leisure park "Anupriškės" which lies next to Gilušis lake, no enthusiast of active recreation can be bored. 9 obstacle courses in the trees have been set up for your entertainment. While conquering the course you will have to overcome numerous obstacles: climb a swinging rope ladder, walk over a monkey bridge, climb over a web, fly on a pendulum and a zip-line, crawl through narrow tunnels and more!

The courses for children and beginners are built at a height of 2-4 metres. If you aim for higher targets, you will need to screw up your courage: if you decide to try the Black course, get ready for a height of 10 metres.

If you want to relax and enjoy the amazing views of the forest and a flight of a dizzying height, try the course "Flight". It is a 220-metre long flight across a valley. You can bet that the flight deserves its name!

The "Spiderman" course is recommended for active people. You will have to conquer the course with no safety belts; only the web below will be there to protect you. So take not only your strength but also your courage!

"Anupriškės" park has plenty of other types of entertainment to offer such as horseriding, fishing, boating on Gilušis Lake, swamp hiking, sporting, etc. We recommend that you choose accommodation in rest houses or lodging houses.

There is an 80 seat restaurant attached to the park where you can have a traditional Lithuanian meal as well as dishes from other European countries.

Places of interest

"Anupriškės" park is only 10 kilometres away from Trakai. Every year Trakai attracts millions of visitors from all over the world. It is a resort-style destination famous for the numerous lakes in the area, which total over 200. Different leisure activities, such as sailing, kayaking, boating, canoeing, swimming and many other entertainment activities are very popular in the area.

A 16th-century castle situated on an island in Lake Galvė, is a reminder of the period of

the Grand Duchy of Lithuania, when Lithuanians ruled vast territories extending to the Black Sea. It is the only castle in Eastern Europe built on an island. Visit the Trakai Museum of History and see the exhibition there.

11. "Ąžuolynė" entertainment park

The "Ążuolynė" entertainment park is located in Aukštadvaris Regional Park, on the bank of a lake. If you are tired of the hectic city life and wish to enjoy the freshness of nature, this is the place for you.

5 obstacle courses of varying difficulty have been built in the park. Children of 3 and above can try a course that is 2 metres in height and includes a 40-metre long flight. Visitors, who are in the park for the first time, are first of all taken to the second-level course (the so-called two-acorn course), where they are instructed on the usage of equipment and introduced to safety requirements. This course is pretty simple and reaches only 3.5 metres in height.

Other courses are harder: their height exceeds 15 metres. The longest track is 140 metres long. You will need courage, stamina, and brains to conquer the courses. Admirers of flights will also find plenty on offer. There are two 90-metre and 120-metre long flights across a lake and even a 350-metre flight called "Ažuolas" (Oak) in which you will be flying at the height of 20 metres. In addition, the homestead offers other leisure activities: play basketball, volleyball or mini-football, enjoy the warmth of a sauna, lay back by a fireplace, or swim in an outdoor pool or a lake with two 2-metre and 5-metre high diving boards built on its shore.


There is a hut suitable for accommodating up to 100 guests, places for bonfires, and a banquet hall for 40 guests. Staying overnight is possible in the homestead or the camp site located nearby.



Places of interest

The most famous site in the area is a 40-metre deep funnel-shaped Devil's Hole, the origin of which is still unclear. There are many legends about how it was formed. Formerly it was believed that the site used to be a place where devils and other supernatural creatures lived. You will find the hole 3.8 kilometres from Aukštadvaris, on the way to Beižionys, near Škilėtas Lake.

Historically difficult periods for Lithuania are signalled by a **Gallows Hill**, situated near the village of Aukštadvaris. Stories relate how insurgents were executed by hanging on the hill in tsarist Russia's attempts to suppress the 1863 uprising in Lithuania.

It is a common thing to hear a triumphant Tarzan style yell in the depths of Dzūkija, by the Nemunas River. Fishermen no longer fear the sight of a person flying over the river. Everyone knows that it is a visitor to the adventure park.

This park is distinct from others for its variety of heights, which is achieved due to the picturesque scarps of the Nemunas and many tall old trees which are suitable not only to equip fine trails but also create a mood of mysteriousness.

The park contains 7 courses. To conquer some of them, much determination and strength will be required but it is certainly worthwhile doing so as in the end you can



yell with triumph: "I did it!". The Red Route will take you to a height of 19 metres.

Try a flight across the largest river in Lithuania – the Nemunas. Its height varies from 3 to 16 metres. Though you do not need to be an athlete to enjoy the tour, there is one thing you will definitely need for this activity – determination.

An exceptional ride in the park is the free falling swing "Big Swing". The swing is situated on a hill and propels you to a 30 metres height. Feel freefall of about 12 metres! Depending on a person's weight, it will keep swinging for around 5 minutes.

Places of interest

Do not miss the chance to see Alytus. You will get to observe lots of rare and protected plants in the Vidzgiris botanical reserve. Nature lovers can take a walk along an ecological educational route leading to the Radžiūnai Mound.

Those who love exercise can go to Lokeneliai village in the Jonava district where they will find at least 6 courses set up among the trees. You will slide from tree to tree on a skateboard along a rope a few metres off the ground, trek your way along suspended ladders and fly some thirty metres on a rope swing through the air.

All the courses in the park are worth trying: from the Yellow (easiest) to the horrific Black course. The height of the courses varies from 2.5 to 15 metres. In addition, you will find three flights one of them being 15 metres off the ground.

The latest and "hottest" news is an adventure attraction called "Cosmic Catapult". Imagine that you are being catapulted to a height of 18 metres. Even the most courageous partici-







pants take fright as at that moment one has a thought that they will land on ... the Moon.

Not done yet? "Lokes peda" also has daredevil ground-gripping race tours with 4-wheeled motorcycles through untilled fields, steep hillsides and stream-cut ravines.

Do you prefer more peaceful entertainment? Take a hot air balloon flight, try archery or airgun or slingshot shooting.

If you feel peckish, grill a roast – a shed is available to hire, barbecue equipment and-firewood may also be provided.

In the evening, relax in a hot sauna or pamper yourself by soaking in a Japanese tub.

"Lušies kelias" (Lynx's route), one of the first adventure parks in Lithuania, is situated close to the most popular Lithuanian seaside resort town Palanga. Do not miss it.

Think you can climb trees as skilfully as a lynx! You will believe so having completed the courses of "Lūšies kelias". All 5 of them require courage and determination to overcome your fear. Wooden casks, swinging beams, suspended bridges, crisscrossed walks – they are not there for you to observe but to try for yourself.

Once you have managed to complete the course requiring lots of strength, you deserve a reward. You will get it by 5 dizzying flights, one of them being 140 metres long. Moreover, when you conquer the highest-difficulty Tarzan course, you can feel proud of yourself. It means that there are no obstacles that can stop you.

In turn, kids will have the unique experience of walking on water. No miracles are









involved here! You will just be enclosed with a huge transparent water walking ball and can enjoy a walk on a water pond whilst keeping your feet dry. Only the strongest are able to do this for more than a couple of minutes.

Places of interest

The area used to be a Bronze Age settlement. To this day you can still find fragments of pots, spearheads, scrapers and other ancient items. You may also be lucky and find a piece that was last touched by human hands three thousand years ago.

If you are by the seaside, it is worth visiting Naglis Hill. It is a 15-metre high Baltic coastal dune and it used to be a sacred place for Lithuanians. It was a sacrificial hill where people burnt sacred fire and conducted different rituals.

This is the freshest adventure park in Lithuania with new and **unprecedented ideas**. Just taking a look at the obstacle courses you might think that it is impossible! But if you just focus and collect your courage and determination, it will become clear to you that you are capable of much more than you thought!



The total length of all 6 courses varying in difficulty is 1.5 km. They include 82 types of activity, 15 of them are flights on a rope. The arrangement of the courses is considerably different from all other parks, i.e. they are located in a very small area – just 0.7 ha. It includes a unique spacious (3 D) configuration of the courses. In numerous places, platforms of trails off varying abilities have been installed in the same trees. Some of them even encompass three courses of varying difficulty. While completing your course you will at the same time see your family members or friends on the other courses.

The centre includes activities that are not available at any other adventure parks in Lithu-



ania. The sense of space is intensified by the fact that in navigating the course you emerge at the same place in the park – the only difference being the height. The Black Course in Belmontas park is the longest trail in Lithuania. Its length totals 259 metres and the height in some places reaches 16 metres from the ground. So, if you manage to complete it, this can be something to boast about to your friends.

At the end of your adventure tour you will reach the peak via a 333-metre rope from a 40-metre-high slope. With the wind around you, you will fly from Tuputiškės back to Belmontas. A huge dose of adrenaline and excitement is guaranteed!

Places of interest

Once in this place, on the bank of the Vilnelė river, stood a huge French-style mill. Later the remains were restored and the territory of the dam was turned into an entertainment and leisure complex. The whole complex is designed in the style of the early 20th century. Authentic architecture, the roaring Vilnia river in the forceful dam, seven bridges across the canal and mysterious pe-

destrian paths, summerhouses and flower gardens create a romantic atmosphere.

On the right bank of the Vilnia River you can see the Pūčkoriai geological exposure. It is 65 metres high. This is one of the highest exposures in Lithuania and was declared a geological monument. Layers that are 20 thousand years old are open for us to enjoy. It is interesting not only to observe but also to look around from the top, having climbed up there. Climb on Pūčkoriai Mound and Rokantiškės Mound and visit Rokantiškės castle ruins. It is believed that one of the oldest castles in Lithuania used to stand here...

Horse riding clubs

A wild ride on a gallant steed is something we have all dreamt of, at least as children. We are fortunate to have perfect conditions for horse riding in Lithuania. Firstly, there are plenty of unpopulated places with its marvellous countryside preserved and untouched by civilisation. It is a real pleasure to have a ride in a forest or a field with no cars intruding on your ride.

Lithuania also features some local horse breeds. Especially complimented upon is the breed of Lithuanian *Žemaitukai* (literally, "Little Samogitians"), which is considered to be one of the oldest horse breeds in Europe. *Žemaitukai* are small but hardy horses, possessing excellent stamina. The *Žemaitukas* breed is acknowledged and protected at an international level. It is listed in the FAO (Food and Agriculture Organisation) Domestic Animal Diversity Information System and the World Watch List for Domestic Animal Diversity. The survival of a couple of other Lithuanian horse breeds – *Trakėnas* (a breed created in Trakėnai, Lithuania Minor), *Stambusis Žemaitukas* (literary, "Heavy

Samogitian", a breed created by cross breeding *žemaitukai* and a breed of larger horses) and *Lietuvos Sunkieji* (Lithuanian Heavy Draft) – are also protected species.

There has been a continued growth in horse riding clubs and stud farms, which, apart from riding tutorials, also offer horseback riding tours varying in length and difficulty.

Kurtuvėnai Regional Park is in the centre of Lithuania on the watershed of the spectacular Venta and Dubysa rivers. It is a hilly land abundant in rivers and lakes, and around 80 percent of the area is covered with forests. The area contains the famous water springs of Svilė, which are believed to possess miraculous healing properties. A trip in the surroundings on a horse will provide an excellent opportunity for you to enjoy the wild beauty of the region untouched by human hands.

Kurtuvėnai horse riding centre operates in the former stabling of Kuruvėnai estate. This is one of the rare places in Lithuania developing both professional horse riding sport and horse riding tourism.

At the moment the Centre's stables holds and trains over thirty horses of the Kurtuvėnai Regional Park as well as private owners. By riding a horse, it will take you from 1 to 5 hours to complete the route and to see the most stunning and interesting sites of Kurtuvėnai Regional Park. Those who are not



eager to ride a horse themselves will be able to have a pleasant journey in a carriage.

Have a fresh swim in the lake and have a meal in the inn "Kryžkelė" ("Crossroad"), which offers various dishes of the estate kitchen, such as beer pickled ham with honey, apple-stuffed carp, kastinys (sour cream butter). Also, tasting a speciality beer of the Kurtuvėnai barn is a must.

One of the most fascinating activities is a tour by horse from Palanga to Kurtuvėnai. Accompanied by experienced supervisors, riders travel through most spectacular areas in Samogitia with regular breaks for rest in cosy farmsteads on the way.

Explore the Kurtuvėnai manor estate: a homestead, the graceful tower of the Church of Saint James the Apostle and the remaining stables on the estate. Take a walk in the renewed park. The hollows of its old trees are home to five kinds of bats, owls and eagle owls. Climb the legendary Girnikai Hill, the highest hill in the Šiauliai region. Drink water from the miraculous springs of Svilė – to this day people believe that the water can heal numerous illnesses.

Vilnius stud farm, established sixty years ago in the valley of the Riešė river among beautiful woods, is **one of the largest** stud farms in Lithuania. 370 studhorses are being bred here. The breeds include *Žemaitukas* (lit., "Little Samogitian"), *Trakėnas* (a breed created in Trakėnai), the Arabian, *Lietuvos sunkusis* (Lithuanian Heavy Draft), and the breed of ponies. Special attention is paid to the preservation of Lithu-





anian horse breeds. Žemaitukai-breed studs' performance in horse riding competitions, in their category, is always very high and they have also won numerous prizes at agriculture exhibitions. Substantial sports achievements have been achieved by *Trakėnas* breed horses, the origin of which goes back to Lithuania Minor. The stud farm will also appeal to those interested in horse riding and breeding history as well as the variety of breeds. A closed riding hall, hippodrome, and horse riding courses are all ideally equipped for learning to ride and also for holding horseback riding competitions.

Visitors can ride a horse or have a ride in a cart in the splendid surroundings of Riešė. Is it not an exotic experience to ride one of the oldest breeds in Europe – *Žemaitukai* – in the surroundings of the last European pagan capital?

Places of interest

Visit The Park of Europe – a surprising, strange and stunning 55-hectareopen-air museum. There are over 100 works of art by artists from 34 countries on display in the park. The Park of Europe is considered one of the most interesting open-air museums in Europe (it is listed in the top fifty category). It is visited by 40-65 thousand people annually. 



The riding club "Origonas", established in Niūronys village is famous in Lithuania for its unique Horse Museum. Everyone interested in horses should visit this place and learn about the history of breeding horses in Lithuania and see antique implements, carts and other horse-related items. A horse riding competition and a traditional festival "Bėk bėk, žirgeli!" is held by the museum every year on the first Saturday of June.

"Origonas" club organises riding excursions in beautiful surroundings: the paths of Niūronys forest and the banks of the Šventoji river. The riders are accompanied by an experienced guide so the tour will be equally suitable for both skilled riders as well as novices.

Do you crave for other types of entertainment? A pleasant ride in a horse drawn carriage lasts for about an hour. The carriage can accommodate around ten adult passengers. In winter the club offers rides in a sledge full of hay. Up to 8 adults can ride at one time.

There stud farm holds 11 sport horses and a number of horses specially trained for tourist trips.



Places of interest

Jonas Biliūnas, one of the most famous Lithuanian writers, was born in Niūronys. If you are interested in history and literature, you should visit the memorial museumfarmstead of Jonas Biliūnas.

The stud farm, situated in the former estate of Peteša in the Vilnius district, is surrounded by the well-groomed forest of Peteša with the

Peteša rivulet flowing through it. The stream is dammed so that in summer you may swim or fish in it after a horse ride.

The name of Peteša has been present in historical sources since the 15th century. Its estate – an ornate complex in the Classicist style – belonged to famous noble families. This used to be a place of exclusive hunting with horses. At the moment the estate is included in the Lithuanian Cultural Heritage List.

The centre keeps horses of various breeds, including the Andalusian Horse, the Friesian, Lithuanian Heavy Draft as well as crossbreeds. Well-trained horses, some of which have been used in movie shoots, are ideal both for experienced riders as well as beginners. They are very obedient, which makes it very safe to ride them. Even if it's your first time in a horse saddle, you will discover the joy of riding!

There are no riding halls in this centre – no matter what the season, horses are rid-

den only in the natural surroundings. For adrenaline-seekers the club has prepared a special route. "Peteša" possesses a rich variety of carriages and offers the chance to have a ride in them and for a moment imagine being noblemen of ancient times. In winter the centre offers horse sledge trips.

Places of interest

On your way to Peteša, you will pass the village of Rudamina. Note the wooden Church of The Blessed Virgin Mary. A few valuable works of art are held insider. Moreover, the village prides itself on the Russian orthodox Nikolajskaja church (otherwise Saint Nicolas church), famous for its icons. Also, take a look at an inn built in the 19th century, which is also an architectural monument.

The remote settlement of Vičiūnai holds the sled dog racing and horse riding club "Araton Team". You are in almost wild nature! The club invites you to wander the leafy and shady woods full of wild animals and to enjoy the silence. Inexperienced riders are led by an instructor.

You can ride as far as to reach Kernavė, which features an impressive collection of



five mounds (unique not only in Lithuania but in the entire Baltic region). It is a monument protected by UNESCO. This is the oldest-inhabited place in Lithuania: people are believed to have lived here since 9000-8000 B.C. The Pajauta valley used to be an area of intense activity. In the 13th century Kernavė became the first Lithuanian capital city.

The "Araton Team" has special suggestions for those seeking maximum thrills one of them being a sled dog ride. The owners keep around 30 dogs, which in winter will take you on a ride by pulling sleds, whereas in other seasons you can enjoy the ride on a three-wheeler or a quad bike.

Easy orienteering hikes with fun obstacle courses are also organised, while adrenaline seekers can opt for night hikes. Finally, those wishing something more mysterious might choose a trip along the women's and men's energy spring routes.

Horse Riding Clubs



This is a small private stud farm in Lentvaris, at the moment keeping four studs.

The club specialises in endurance riding where the ride is slow but a rider covers long distnces. The riders get a map of the area marked with the distance, check points, rest points, and natural obstacles (water, swamps, mounds, etc). Apart from this, the club organises one-day or longer trips by horse. The surrounding areas of Lentvaris are rich in remote forest pathways and roads that allow you to fully enjoy nature's splendour and feel the delight of a ride.

Horse breeding and riding traditions have been well established in Lentvaris. The neo-Gothic palace built in the 19th century, which belonged to the Counts Tiškevičiai, also had a stables. The estate building has survived to this day and it is popular among tourists.

The riding club "Džonis" organises trips in the surroundings of Trakai. An attractive option is a horse ride along the educational path of the Varnikai botanical-zoological reserve. It provides a unique opportunity for you to stay in countryside untouched by civilisation.

The modern riding centre of J.Lenartas is located just 10 kilometres away from the



centre of Klaipėda, close to the Romani settlement. The place is only 2 kilometres from the sea and so the greatest advantage of the centre is the ability to ride by the beautiful

Beginners are recommended to attend the riding school in which you will be taught the basics of riding and will practice the skills you acquire. Additionally, you will be trained in specific riding fields such as dressage and eventing. The closed riding hall is available for riding in all seasons of the year.

In a café-platform you can both enjoy a cup of tea and watch others ride. Aditionally you can buy the necessary items in a shop "Viskas žirgui & raiteliui" ("Everything for a stud and a rider").

Places of interest

While at the seaside, visit The Seaside Regional Park. Should you be interested in military items, stop in Kukuliškiai village to see the forts of World War II. If you crave after nature's beauty - take a walk along the shore of the historical Litorina. 7.5 thousand years ago this used to be the bottom of the sea. Walking on this path you will also see the hill of the Dutch Cap, which is a unique cliff line, formed by a



moving glacier. The height of this dune rises to 24 metres and it used to be a landmark for fishermen and sailors. It now serves as a fantastic attraction for tourists and passers-by.

To sense the spirit of the ancient Curonians it is a must to visit Noriškės village in the Plungė district. Take a ride in the stunning surroundings of the Babrungas river and





Gandinga mound. A castle used to stand on the mound. In fact, historical sources mention it as far back as the 12th century. It was famous for a favourable defence location. An ancient settlement and cemetery nearby signal the active life in the area many years ago. Close to it stand a hill used for giving sacrifices called Apiera Hill, and two hills called Pilikės (literally small castles) by the locals. This site is officially considered as a historical reserve of the Gandinga landscape. Apart from riding Žemaitukas horses, Noreikiškės is a perfect choice if you wish to rest in a remote farmstead on the bank of the Babrungas or have a pleasant stay in a farm sauna.

Air balloon rides

In fine weather one can see tens of colourful air balloons over the largest cities of Lithuania. With its Old Town inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List, Vilnius is one of the few European capitals where hot air ballooning is allowed.

Have you ever seen the Three Crosses or Gediminas Castle from above? And the red-tile roofs of Kaunas or the net of narrow streets alluding to the interwar period? What about the breathtaking views of the Neris and Nemunas river slopes or the majestic Labanoras forest waves laid out below of you? You haven't? Then, it is time to fly!

Enjoy the bird's-eye view, marvel at the spectrum of colours, sense the gentle blowing of the wind, and hear the roaring life around. Even skilled balloonists claim that every flight is moving and unique.

In summer, air balloon rides take place either early in the morning, at 5-9 o'clock, or

in the evening, at 6-9 o'clock. In autumn and spring, morning flights start at around 8 and afternoon flights at around 4 o'clock.

There are usually no vertical air currents at this time. In winter, flights are held at any time there is daylight. The flight takes 1–1.5 hours, or, together with the time for balloon preparation and giving instructions – 3–4 hours.

Everyone can enjoy the balloon ride, as no special preparation is needed. A balloon rises and falls slowly, so passengers do not experience any discomfort.




Those who fly for the first time are "baptised" according to the old traditions of ballooners; they are also granted titles and baptism names, and first-flight certificates are awarded, too.

Good news for winter sport enthusiasts: "SNORAS Snow Arena", an indoor centre for winter entertainment is due to open on April 2011 in Mizarai village, Druskininkai district. It is anticipated that the centre will be among the top 5 indoor ski trails and be unequalled in a range of 1000 kilometres. Isn't it great that skiing will now be available all year round!

The centre covers an area of 8 hectares and contains three ski trails for beginners and skilled skiers under one roof. The total length of the trails totals 1,100 metres.

A trail of 50-metres width and 460-metres length and another 70-metres in width and 150-metres long will be open all year round.

An outdoor trail 40 metres wide and 640 metres long will be open as long as the outside temperature is below plus 5 degrees. The slopes are 66 metres in height and the slope gradient is up to 25 percent. The artificial snow layer is almost as functional as natural snow. 4 elevators will be available for visitors' convenience.

Around 1,000 people can be accommodated at a time in the centre. Apart from skiing, they will be able to ride a snowboard, ice skate, climb the 25-metre wall, etc. Additional services such as restaurants, bars, cafés, and massage salons will also be open to visitors. A hire point for all the necessary equipment will be available. An ice hockey rink and a sledding trail are also planned for the future.

Mizarai village contains a meteorite impact crater which is 5 km in diameter and about 200–250 m in depth and about 500 million years old. It is believed that the crater was formed as a result of a cosmic catastrophe, when a 200 m wide meteorite hit basement rock. Explore the endless immensity of the ice in Lithuania. The frozen Curonian Lagoon attracts not only thousands of fishers but also winter sport lovers. It was just recently that a sail seen on the frozen Curonian Lagoon by Nida would make one marvel. Today almost everyone knows that such a sail belongs to a











sail boat "Ice-Blokart", which is a vessel used by ice sailors cutting the breadth of the lagoon. Ice sailing is a well loved winter activity as the skills are easy to master and the impressions are indescribable. A skilled sailor can reach a speed of 80 km/h! In summer, an iceboat can be ridden on paved roads or sand by simply attaching special wheels to the vessel.

The most popular place for ice sailing in Lithuania is the Curonian Lagoon, though you can also try this activity on the lakes in the Trakai district, and Plateliai (Plungė district) or Rėkyva (Šiauliai district) lakes.

When the ice is safe, try a roundtrip with a unique ice-sled ride from Nida to Ventė Cape. The route is 32 km long. Those who have tried it claim that the fantastic trip leaves an amazing experience on you.



If you think that sledge riding is only for winter, then you are wrong. Sledge riding fans and other speed- and adrenaline-seeking enthusiasts know that they can enjoy a ride on the sledge track on the hill of Kalita in Anykščiai even on the hottest summer days. In winter the hill attracts skiing enthusiasts whereas in other seasons visitors can enjoy a ride on the summer sled track. Kalita hill features varying slopes which provide the chance to experience exciting sensations. The descent track is 330 metres long whereas the ascent section is 155 metres long. The track contains five turns, a steep pitch,





and a loop. Speed can be controlled individually, though every sledge contains an automatic brake that does not allow you to ride at a speed greater than 40 km/h. Additional safety is ensured by safety belts.

Find out what it feels like to ride a sledge in summer: this will be an exhilarating experience putting you back into a good mood for a long time to come!

Tackle the wind and speed ahead on the edge of the wavy sea riding a three-wheel "Blokart" iceboat! They say that learning to ride this vessel is easier than learning to ride a bike. So no sailing experience is necessary and everyone can choose this type of entertainment. The ride on the windy seaside will definitely be an ultimate adventure.

Iceboat rides take place in any season of the year. One of the conditions is the wind speed:



it has to reach at least 6 m/s. You are allowed to iceboat even in bad weather: in such conditions sailors are given special waterproof overalls.

The main routes are the following: Juodkrantė–Smiltynė (20 km) and Smiltynė–Pervalka (30 km), and the ride takes 3.5 h. The route also depends on the direction of the wind. If the wind is fast enough and the sand is well packed, an iceboat can reach a speed of 25–50 km/h.

On completion of the trip sailors stop to eat and rest and once you reach the finish you can order a mobile sauna. After you get hot enough – jump into the whitecaps of the sea!

Places of interest

The Curonian Spit is one of most beautiful places in Lithuania and is inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. You will be overawed by the fantastic view of the dunes that have always charmed tourists and holiday-makers. Climb on the observation deck on The Dune of Parnidis and see the elegance and
